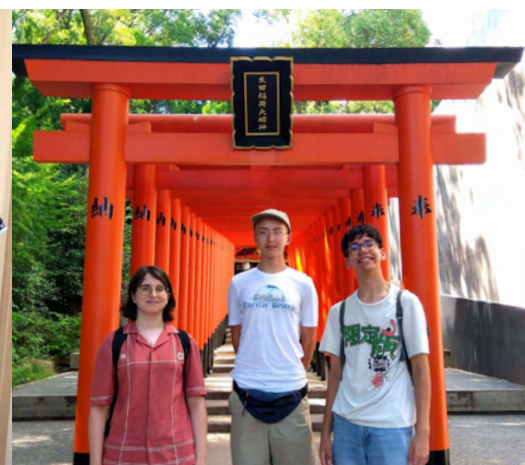

YOUR FIRST DAY

Welcome to Lexis! Your first day is all about helping you settle in and get started on your Japanese learning journey. Please remember to bring your **passport and a copy of your flight ticket itinerary** for registration. You'll have plenty of time to meet other students, enjoy lunch, and participate in a fun afternoon activity.



Online Pre-test Before Arrival

Students are required to take a **simple online pre-test before starting their course**. The results will help us understand your Japanese language level and determine which classroom you should be in.



Arriving at Lexis

When you arrive at the campus, please head straight to **reception**. We will ask for your **passport to complete your registration** and for you to confirm your contact details. After that, you're welcome to relax in our common area and meet some new friends!



Welcome Orientation

Our Head Teacher or Activity Co-ordinator will lead a **short orientation** to introduce you to our school and what to expect. You'll learn all about:

- Life at Lexis and in your homestay
- Our classes and learning program
- Fun local activities and excursions
- Important Rules and Regulations

You will receive your welcome pack and get your passport back. We'll also ask you to sign a commitment to speak only Japanese at school. This is the best way to become a great Japanese speaker, so let's get started!



Your Personal Interview

You will have a chat with a teacher. We'll talk about how you're settling in with your **homestay family, your Japanese goals, and review your online pre-test**. We will also give you your **timetable and books**. You can ask us anything you like!



Classroom / First Lesson

You will be **allocated to your classroom** where you will take part in your first lesson. You will have the opportunity to meet your Japanese teacher and classmates and introduce yourself.



Lunch Break

There are plenty of restaurants, food courts, bakeries, convenience stores, and fast-food options around campus. The cost is typically around US\$5 to US\$10. Students can **enjoy a variety of Asian and Western food**.



Fun Activities

Get ready for fun activities! Depending on the program, you'll either take part in **fun, interactive activities near your campus - Kobe**. Afterward, you can relax by watching a movie or hanging around with new friends before heading back to your accommodation.
